HERD DESCRIPTION AND BREEDING SYSTEM

Farm situation

Purchase of first limousin cows in 1995. Cyrille sets up as a farmer in 2002 in a GAEC with her father, Francis.

Today, Cyrille farms alone after her sister joined the GAEC in 2005. Her sister quit the business in 2016 and her parents retired in 2017.

Herd description

200 cows

The main (80%) calving period extends is in September – October but it can extend out to November - January.

In winter, livestock are housed in a loose covered yard and are fed hay, and silage for cows.

The rest of the year, livestock are out at grass on a rotational grazing system in batches of 20 females or 15 males.
