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La Rêverie Collection

La Rêverie is a collection shaped by moments of quiet reflection. Its designs capture the softness of memory and daydreams.

The collection begins with Papilio botanical, where the elegant whimsy of butterflies informs movement and composition with their crisp, fresh colorations. A gentle, diffused light then settles over our Dahlia floral, evoking a luminous sense of nostalgia.

From there, the collection turns east, drawing on Asian influences through layered tropical foliage, stylized dragons, and pagoda-inspired architectural elements. These narratives resolve in the snow-covered mountains of Niseko, Japan, interpreted through the disciplined expressiveness of sumi-e ink drawing, where negative space and motion are as intentional as line.

Complementing the decorative fabrics are indoor/outdoor textiles with performance qualities, colored to echo the collection's palette and themes. Designed for versatility, they allow La Rêverie to transition seamlessly between interior and exterior spaces, balancing beauty, durability, and considered design.

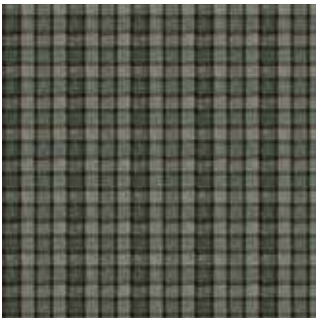

This design is rooted in a series of sumi-e (ink drawing) paintings created for Kazumi's 2024 gallery exhibition. Inspired by the majestic, snow-covered mountain ranges of Niseko, Hokkaido, the artist developed a contemplative series of winter landscapes that capture both scale and stillness.

The resulting fabric and wallpaper design merges these atmospheric sumi-e influences with the expressive landscape language of Josef Frank, creating a composition in which poetic brushstrokes meet modernist vitality. For the wall, the Niseko pattern is printed on a beautiful matte non-woven ground.
